





What is Pelvic Organ Prolapse or Stress Urinary Leakage?

Sometimes pelvic organs — such as the bladder or uterus — shift downward due to childbirth, aging, or the weakening of pelvic floor tissue. This may lead to:

- Pelvic pressure or fullness
- Leakage when laughing, coughing, or exercising
- Discomfort during activity or intimacy

A pessary can help support these organs, reduce symptoms, and restore day-to-day comfort.

How Can a Pessary Help Me?

- Helps support pelvic organs inside the vagina
- Reduces pressure and urinary leakage
- Can be used as an alternative to or alongside surgery
- Designed for ongoing, active lifestyles

FAQs

Will I feel the pessary once it's in place?

No — with the correct size and position, you shouldn't feel it during daily life.

If you do feel irritation or pressure, your provider may adjust the fit

Can I have sex while wearing a pessary?

Yes, depending on the type. Some pessaries stay in place for intercourse, while others are removed beforehand.

Are there different types of pessaries?

Absolutely. Your clinician will help choose the right shape and size for your needs.

Sometimes a refitting is needed for the best comfort — that's normal.



Caring for Your Pessary

Your provider will give clear instructions for removal, reinsertion, and cleaning—depending on the pessary type you use.

Follow-Up Care Tips:

- First follow-up usually in 2–3 weeks
- Routine check-ins every few months to monitor comfort and tissue health
- Contact your clinician if you notice discharge, odor, or difficulty using the bathroom

Safety Note*

Let your care team know before an MRI or X-ray.

Some pessaries contain metal and must be removed beforehand.
